

Designated Parade Safety



Wheel Walkers

In order to put safety first and reduce gaps between entries during the parade, maintain an appropriate and safe pace, and ensure a safe and entertaining parade for all of our participants, **all Parade units are required to provide designated parade unit wheel walkers.**

Wheel Walkers are asked to: (Please review these duties with your wheel walkers)

- Walk on either side of every moving vehicle, next to the wheels, to ensure that the area in front of their unit is clear of any pedestrians or other parade units.
- Maintain the movement and pacing in the parade of all vehicles and marchers belonging to their unit, maintaining a distance approximately 20 feet from the unit ahead of them;
- Carry their unit designation number, depending upon the type of unit they are a part of, so that announcers can readily identify your unit and ensure that they have the correct announcement;
- Serve as a designated contact for their unit for parade monitors along the route;
- Direct their unit to designated breakdown areas at the end of the parade (our volunteers assist with providing directions).

Walker requirements are as follows:

Marching Units - 01-50 People: 2 Parade Liaisons

51-100 People: 4 Parade Liaisons

Decorated Vehicle(s) - 2 Wheel Walkers for each vehicle (walk along front wheels of vehicle)

Parade Float / Major Decorated Vehicle - 4 Wheel Walkers for each vehicle (walk along each wheel of vehicle)
